Dear Han Hong Lee,

Thank you for your message. We evaluated the Journal of Gastric Cancer for inclusion in SCIE when we selected it for ESCI. I regret to inform you that we rejected the journal for inclusion in SCIE. The primary reason for this decision was <u>low citation activity</u>. We also noted that the <u>editorial board and authors are primarily regional</u>; that is, there is little international diversity. We found, too, that some authors are repeated within the same issue.

With the above in mind, we did not select the journal for inclusion in SCIE. You may submit the journal to us for <u>SCIE evaluation again in November 2018</u> by using the form at <u>http://ip-science.thomsonreuters.com/info/journalsubmission-front/</u>.



Editorial Triage


In this step, the Web of Science editors review the journal to determine whether a full editorial evaluation is merited. There is no embargo period for re-submission if a journal does not pass editorial triage in its first evaluation. If a journal is subsequently re-submitted and fails editorial triage for a second consecutive time, re-submission is subject to an embargo period of one year.

Editorial Evaluation (quality)

In this step, the Web of Science editors are checking for alignment between the journal's title, stated scope, the composition of its editorial board and authorship, and its published content. They are also looking for evidence of editorial rigour and adherence to community standards.

Responsibility and accountability for the quality of all published content, including any special issue content, lies with the publisher and the editorial board of the journal.

If a journal does not pass this step, re-submission is subject to an embargo period of at least two years.

This title's contents and <u>citations have improved but remain too dependent</u> <u>on Korean editorial board members</u> and authors to justify adding to the Web of Science Core collection at this time.

Dear Han Hong Lee,

Thank you for your message. We evaluated the Journal of Gastric Cancer for inclusion in SCIE when we selected it for ESCI. I regret to inform you that we rejected the journal for inclusion in SCIE. The primary reason for this decision was <u>low citation activity</u>. We also noted that the <u>editorial board and authors are primarily regional</u>; that is, there is little international diversity. We found, too, that <u>some authors are repeated within the same issue</u>.

With the above in mind, we did not select the journal for inclusion in SCIE. You may submit the journal to us for <u>SCIE evaluation again in November 2018</u> by using the form at <u>http://ip-science.thomsonreuters.com/info/journalsubmission-front/</u>.

Dear Matt,

Thank you very much for your kind explanation on our journal. We also appreciate you for your selection of our journal to ESCI. It will be good chance for our journal to be connected to the international journal network via ESCI.

We understood that the primary reason not to be selected as SCIE journal was low citation activity. Also, the shortness is regional editorial board and authors. The same author's articles in the same issue are another problem.

We checked the impact factor and total citation of our journal again in Web of Science through cited reference search function. Total 151 articles of *Journal of Gastric Cancer* has been cited 621 times by Web of Science articles. 2015 Impact factor can be calculated as 91/80=1.1375 at now and 2014 impact factor can be calculated as 113/78=1.449. We are not sure what is the criteria of low citation. When we compare this value to present SCIE journal in JCR, it corresponds to 83.4% in the category of ONCOLOGY and 52.0% in the category of SURGERY. We believe that 2015 impact in April 2016, may be able to soar to more than 1.5. The criteria of low citation means better than 70 or 80% of present JCR, we will try to publich high quality articles at our best.

As for editors' and authors' multi-nationality, Yes, we will invite editors from all over the world and we will also recruit the manuscript from all over the world.

As for same author's articles in the same issue, we found that in the recent issue, there were two papers submitted by same author as corresponding author. We are not sure if "two submissions in one issue by same author" is a hindrance or shortness in the international journal publishing standard. We could not hear about it from any editors. Is it your criteria to consider for inclusion to SCIE? We do not think that "submission of two manuscripts to one issue by same corresponding author" may deter integrity of the journal. We believe that important issue is the quality of article. Those articles can be published after process of vigorous peer review. However, it is the problem, we will not publish same corresponding author's article at the same issue.

Your comments were valuable to me to edit our journal. Would you please inform us about above statements? It will be our great pleasure if we can hear from you soon.

Would mind if we ask you to re-evaluate our journal after one year? We can promise you that we will promote our journal according to your suggestion as soon as possible.

Please pardon me if above our opinion to your criteria was impolite to you.

We appreciate you for your sincere evaluation of our journal and inclusion to ESCI. It is a great benefit for our journal to be connected with other privileged journals in Web of Science for the better presentation to worldwide researchers.

May we ask you a favour?

We and editorial board members re-read your comment as follows several time and discussed:

This fitle's contents and citations have improved but remain too dependent on Korean editorial board members and authors to justify adding to the Web of Science Core collection at this time.

We discussed what is the meaning of "too dependent on Korean editorial board members and authors." It is guessed that citation except from Korea was too low to be SCIE journal. However, the citation by other Korean researchers could not be controlled by editorial board members since many areas are concerned in gastric cancer besides our society members. We could not persuade them to cite our journal or refrain them from citing our journal. It is the natural phenomena that Korean researchers have cited research results from Korea.

We also calculated how much portion of citations from Korean researchers and editorial board members affected the total citation or recent year impact factors.

At first, numbers of article contributed to total citation from Web of Science were as followings:

2011, 1; 2012, 39; 2013, 126; 2014, 226; and 2015, 229.


Sum of total citation is 621. Out of them, number of articles from Korea is 163 (26.2%). According to year, the total citation from Korea is as follows:

2011, 1; 2012, 12 (30.8%); 2013, 37 (29.4%); 2014, 58(25.7%); and 2015, 55 (24.0%).

Thank you for your message and the information you provide below. I appreciate the amount of research you performed on behalf of the journal.

Thomson Reuters does not reopen evaluations once it has made its coverage decision. Per my original note, the journal is eligible for evaluation again in November 2018. In the meantime, we will index the journal in ESCI.

Issues will begin to appear in ESCI in January 2016. Once content has been indexed and displays in product, two things will occur: First, the journal will become discoverable to a much broader audience, enhancing its visibility in its field. Second, the journal's performances will become transparent not only to Thomson Reuters, but also to you, and the journal's authors, both those who have contributed and those who are considering doing so.

With the above in mind, I'm not able to tell you that we will evaluate the journal again at this time next year. I recommend that we revisit that possibility in November 2016. Please be in touch with me then. At that time, because the journal will be indexed in ESCI, its performance will be plain, and it will be a simpler matter for both you and us to determine whether or not we should readjust the journal's evaluation schedule.
